



# BFE / Ecosystem




The BFE is the tool used to edit/create bibframe records

- Been a good platform for the pilot developing the editor and profiles.



## Why Refactor

- BF2MARC opens up workflow possibilities.
- Opportunity to make a tool focused on creating Bibframe records specifically.
- Expanded number of pilot participants.
- Focus on the user experience of creating a Bibframe record.



#### **Process**

  So primary focus is on the user interface and experience.
- NDMSO contracted SAMHÆNG to do the UX consulting and design process first before developing anything.
- Consultants met with LC catalogers over several months discussing the existing BFE and a new design.








### Process - Current Step

- Build proof-of-concept to test UI assumptions and how they work with current profiles.
- Evaluate next steps for building out the editor.

### Process - Technology

- Original BFE was a Jquery client with NodeJS backend. In memory/ json file data store backend.
- Updating the tech but trying not to make it too complicated, RDF is complicated enough. Choices matter and impact resources needed to maintain and upgrade.
- This proof-of-concept is using Vue.js for the frontend and will use NodeJS and a document store DB for the backend (hopefully in a docker container).
